GUKI is a cultural space whose outlines are clearly defined; within these outlines there is maximum flexibility. Both indoors and outside, the space can be rearranged continuously. It allows GUKI to shift its focus away from conventional cultural institutions.

GUKI creates art *ad hoc*. A residence program with open workspaces, semi-open ateliers, and secluded dormitories is provided to artists from the Nordics, the East, and the West. An education program is open for Helsinki-based artists-in-training.

GUKI commissions art. Each year, one artist, architect, or designer is invited to make a new pavillion or relational art work. Other works are commissioned through open calls and online crowd-supported projects.

GUKI shows, sells, and shares art. Works produced are exhibited and sold on site and online. After exhibition, the pavilions and relational art works are shipped to other cultural spaces in Helsinki and beyond.
