

Light is art, Guggenheim Helsinki is a vessel through which art and light passes through.

Being situated at Etelasatama, site marking the threshold between water and inland, the past and the future.

Surrounded by historical sites, shipping terminals and lush parklands we are providing a visual and physical connection in the master planning of the site.

Commanding corten steel masses of Guggenheim sit suspended on glass stilts that allow for light to pass through them

in the evening as light channels travelling from ground to the sky.

Comprising of three concourse levels that connect all of the individual towers internal stilts and created by moving geometries that create unique individual spaces for exhibition.

Guggenheim at the shores of Etelasatama will be a beacon of light,

a port lighthouse drawing in crowds to experience the space and artwork contained within.
