



## GUGGENHEIM HELSINKI

Guggenheim Helsinki is inspired by the natural forms of Finnish lakes and the elegant sensibility of the Northern Lights. The museum footprint is molded to create a fluid and continuous form that provides an iconic presence on the waterfront, a link that connects the city and park to the harbor and an open interface that provides permeable views through to the water. The Northern Lights effect is shown in the openings of the building. The aurora's fluid lines are reflected in multiple waves on the façade that carves and defines the openings and roofline of the museum building. Multiple layers of frost, frit and color create a delicate atmosphere that reflects the dynamic and extraordinary aura of the Northern Lights. This soft and flowing form and gently blends the museum with its urban surroundings and into the waterfront waves.
