

**PRESS SUMMARY**

A simple curved shell dedicated to art and culture, with an eye to the sea, responds gently to the park hill. Its roof promenade continues the city public space in front of the quay.

It is populated with an orchard of simmering mirrors that flood the museum galleries with daylight, while taking part in the city life, such as Lux Helsinki or the Summer Festival.

A large mobile LED canopy facing the city to the north welcomes the visitors into a totally modular wooden construction, housing the gallery spaces at its heart.

The size, the illumination as well as the climate of each gallery module are independently adjustable, from very high to shallow, from wide to narrow, from a black box to a bright open room.

The presence of artists at work can be felt everywhere, in a space devoted to the respect of humanity and of the environment.
