The museum Metsä Vuori Guggenheim is a building inspired by the Moraine layers and the small island found around in the Finnish landscape.

A building that appears part of a unique scenic landscape seen in the horizon and that gently reveals its mesmerizing landscape of nature and connectivity.

It's a building, a landscape, a hilltop that revitalizes Eteläsatama and ties the different parts of the city, from north the market square to the Olympia terminal, together and becomes a visual and physical extension of Tähtitornin vuori park down to the harbor front.

The building is therefore an art scape that invites visitors and inhabitants of Helsinki to interact on a public platform through the intervention of art.

The museum Metsä Vuori Guggenheim will become a timeless piece of architecture constituted in contemporary ideas and open for future creativities for the people and the city.
