The mass of the museum and the atrium space are borrowed from the surrounding city - the block shaped building follows the existing grid structure. Also the massing and the openings of the building have found their inspiration from the surrounding architecture and cityscape. In addition it creates vivid and interesting urban spaces around it.

The ground floor of the building is continuity for the lively squares in the Kauppatori area. Together they create a line of spaces reflecting one another. Primary Exhibition Galleries are located on the first and second floor. The visitors can explore the surrounding city from the selected views on each floor.

The facades of the museum are Finnish stone: inspired by the surrounding city centre, marine climate and objective to sustainability and ecology. The organic shaped sympathetic stone columns invite people to explore the many delights of Guggenheim Museum.
